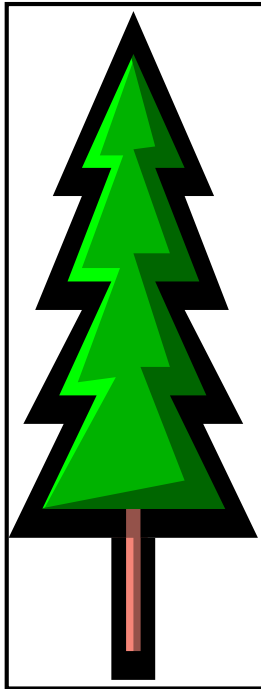

1) Trees must be ordered online. NO orders will be taken by mail or telephone.

Payment in full is required when order is placed. (credit card or check)

2) All returned checks are subject to an additional fee.

3) The SWCD reserves the right to cancel your order and refund the payment if trees become unavailable. Refunds will not be made for any other reason.

4) You will be notified in the Spring by postcard and email when the trees can be picked up in **Rockville County Park**
One day only usually the last Friday at the end of April or the first Friday in May.

5) If you are unable to pick up your order on the designated day please make arrangements to have someone pick up your order for you.

6) Trees cannot be resold.

7) Trees planted on CRP and RIM land are tax exempt. Landowner must complete & sign ST3 to claim exemption.
Please contact the office for special instructions.

8) Transplants are seedlings that have spent a year or more in a transplant bed. A transplant bed provides the young seedling more care than it would receive in a field and more room than it would have in a seedbed.
